Monetary and gift awards will be selected after works are in the gallery. They will be announced at the opening reception. Previous competition award donors include: The Artery of Davis; Individual donors: Pat and Gene Hill, Suppliers: Alpha Fired Art, Creative Ceramics and Glass, East Bay Clay, Laguna Clay, Industrial Minerals, Clay People, Clay Planet, Quyle Kilns Clay Company, Association of Clay and Glass Artists of California.

Juror: Scott Parady got his MFA from Penn State University and currently is a ceramics professor at Sacramento State University in Sacramento, CA. Most of the works that Parady creates is hand built by pinching clay while working slowly on a potter's wheel as opposed to the traditional throwing method. He, then, fires the work in his Anagama wood fire kiln. Parady began this hand-building technique because he started to dig his own clay in the late 1990's.
